## 1. Introduction

**edk** kits have been designed for the ROLAND TD-17 V-DRUMS ONLY !!!

The file you purchased from **edrumkits.com** is a ZIP file.

You will automatically receive a link to download the file on the email address you give us.

The ZIP file contains one (or more, if you purchased a pack) Roland TD0 file compatible with Roland TD-17 module.

The Roland TD0 file already includes samples and pad settings.

Each drum kit contains HQ samples for snare, toms & kick and sometimes for snare & toms rims. All cymbals are coming from original TD-17 library and have been adjusted to match with the kit.



## 2. Load a single **edk** drum kit into TD-17 module

### Note :

- if you have purchased one or more single **edk** ekits or if you have purchased an **edk** Collection Pack, follow this process to load purchased kits into your TD-17 module.
- Repeat this procedure for each individual kits you purchased

### Process :

TD-17 module can only load user kits using an SD card.

The SD or SDHC card should be more than 1Gb.

All user kits should be place into "SD root\ROLAND\TD-17\KIT.

All user kits should be named "KIT-xxx.TD0". xxx = kit number.

**edk** kits are already packaged into TD0 files with correct name.

You just have to :

- Unzip downloaded file
- Extract .TD0 files into the ROLAND\TD-17\KIT directory of your SD card
- Insert your SD card into your module
- And then :

PRESS OTHER button

SCROLL DOWN

SAVE / LOAD

LOAD (be sure you select **LOAD** to avoid overwriting an **edk** Kit with your current kit)

Be sure the "**With User Sample**" is checked

Select the kit from SD card you want to load

Select the User number where the kit will be saved into your module

EXECUTE

ENTER

PROCESSING... Kit is loaded -> COMPLETED

If the message "USER SAMPLE MEMORY FULL!" is displayed, it means you can't load the **edk** Kit because the module memory is already full.

You have to free the module memory in deleting user samples.



### 3. Load a backup

Note :

- If you have purchased the EDK FULL Rock Backup or the Rock&Metal Backup, follow this process.
- A backup file contains all module / pads / user kits parameters and all samples. **All your existing parameters, setup, users kits... will be replaced.**
- If you want to keep your module configuration, make your own backup before loading **edk** backup.

Process :

TD-17 module can only load backup using an SD card.

All backup should be place into "SD root\ROLAND\TD-17\BACKUP.

You just have to :

- Unzip downloaded file
- Extract .TD0 backup file into the ROLAND\TD-17\BACKUP directory of your SD card
- Insert your SD card into your module
- And then :

PRESS SETUP button

SD CARD

Load Backup

**Be sure the "User Sample" is checked**

Select the **Bank number** : BANK 1 for EDK FULL (ROCK) or BANK 2 for EDK R&M BKUP

EXECUTE

ENTER or CANCEL



The backup is loaded and your module is fully configured with **edk** parameters, settings and drum kits.



## 4. Troubleshooting

### 1. After having loaded a kit or backup, sounds are strange

This happens if you don't check the "With User Samples" check box. Only kit settings are loaded but not the samples, then the module plays randomly some sounds already existing into the module.

Load again kit or backup and check the box !

### 2. You have the message "USER SAMPLE MEMORY FULL"

The memory of your module is full and there is no more space to load the kit.

You have to free space in deleting existing user samples.

We recommend to create multiple backup regarding your use.

For example create a backup with the few kits you use for your Rock band, another one with kits for your Metal band... It's then very easy to switch from one backup to another and it configures your TD17 for a specific usage.

### 3. When you load a kit or backup you don't see an EDK kit to select and load

Be sure you place the TD0 file in the good directory of your SD card and be sure that the filename is the good format as indicated above.

### **ROCK COLLECTION KITS for Roland TD-17**

**edk ROCK 1 – Live 70's**

This combination of drums offers the atmosphere of the live rock music. The loud snare and the roundness of toms add to the whole of this kit the color of the “on stage” performance from the 70's.

**edk ROCK 2 - Medium Pop Rock**

Light and clean, but nevertheless tight enough, this kit will give an appropriate answer to rock and pop bands, as the good and accurate partner of playing sessions.

**edk ROCK 3 – Rock Studio**

Definitely sharp, edk ROCK 3 will find his place as the compelling tool for recording rock sessions. Strong and effective, edk Rock 3 will give an ultimate higher level to all the compositions.

**edk ROCK 4 – Black Exploitation**

Rock, soul, reggae, ska, jazz... edk ROCK 4's got the Blaxploitation style. The specific and indispensable sound of all the kind of shapes of music which raised from the roots of US black world.

**edk ROCK 5 - Rock 90's**

This kit reminds the inevitable sound of the nineties rock productions. Deep, edk ROCK 5 gives to the drums the “onward” position so required by all the record places of this period.



### **edk ROCK 6 – Live Late 80's**

Back in the live again ! But we let behind us the 70's to enter in the 90's. This second "Rock Live" version from the edk's Rock Collection will confer an emphasis to the drums which would satisfy every players in search of a more modern sound.

### **edk ROCK 7 - 80's Tight**

Tight and dry, edk ROCK 7 only wants to reach one target : play, just play. In the spirit of the punk-rock or new-wave currents, this kit gives to the drums of the simplicity and the effectiveness of an instrument in the service of the band.

### **edk ROCK 8 - MTV Rock**

Could you remember the MTV of the end of the century ? Gimme all your lovin'... Cryin'... and so many others... edk ROCK 8 gives you the dive into the sound of a period of the history of the musical industry... when videos on TV and productions goes together.

### **edk ROCK 9 - Jazz Rock Fusion**

Musicians want to explore new paths. edk ROCK 9 is created for this purpose. Jazz, rock Fusion... this kit keeps rocks but it will give to drum's playing some other horizons. This approach can let the place to a new percussive force with other rhythmic companions.
